Evacuation order issued for properties on Allenby Road south of Duncan

DUNCAN, BC – An <u>Evacuation Order</u> has been issued by Cowichan Valley Regional District (CVRD) for a number of properties on Allenby Road immediately south of Duncan, BC.

Several properties on Allenby Road along the Cowichan River are subject to the <u>evacuation</u> <u>order</u>. The evacuation order was issued due to immediate danger to life safety caused by extremely high river flows causing flooding. Debris in fast moving water may cause damage and pose a threat to life and property.

Those under Evacuation Order should:

- Follow the safest travel route available
- Self-register online: Emergency Support Services (ESS) at https://ess.gov.bc.ca/ to report that you have safely left the area. If you are unable to register online, proceed to the Cowichan Community Centre on James Street in Duncan to register in person
- If you need transportation assistance from the area, advise the person providing this notice or call 778-403-4040
- Shut off all gas and electrical appliances, other than refrigerators and freezers
- Close all windows and doors
- Close gates (latch) but do not lock
- Gather your family and, if you have room, take a neighbour or someone needing transportation. Do not use more vehicles then you have to
- Take critical items (medicine, purse, wallet, and keys) only if they are immediately available. Take pets in pet kennels or on leash
- Take COVID-19 precautions: bring masks and sanitizer and maintain social distancing
