Applicants must be:

- Eligible to work in Canada,
- Be 16 years of age or older,
- Available to attend a training session scheduled September 28, 2022, 6:00 p.m.,
- Available to work on Election Day, Saturday, October 15, 2022, from 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 p.m.,
- Basic literacy skills (reading, writing and comprehension),
- Basic interpersonal skills, including the ability to exercise impartiality,
- Ability to serve voters with disabilities,
- Ability to perform repetitive tasks,
- Basic arithmetical and analytical skills,
- Good attention to detail,
- Ability to adhere to directions and standards,
- Ability to learn in a short time frame, and
- Polite and courteous.

NOTE: To avoid public perception of conflict of interest, Election Officials with an association to a candidate's campaign for the 2022 General Local Election will not be permitted to be an Election Official for this vote.
