

## **PROCLAMATION**

## **British Home Children Day**

WHEREAS British Home Children Day is intended to promote awareness of child

emigration across Canada who were used as indentured farm workers and domestics, a little-known aspect of joint Canadian and British history; and

WHEREAS from 1869 to 1948 over 100,000 children were sent from Britain to Canada

with the idea of the majority becoming indentured labourers and domestics;

and

WHEREAS children were sent to Canada from England by over 50 organizations

including Fairbridge Farms, Fegan Homes, the Salvation Army and churches of all denominations. Often called Canada's Nation Builders, their vast contributions to our country should never be forgotten. Descendants of these

children number in the millions in Canada alone; and

WHEREAS the mandate of the British Home Children Advocacy and Research

Association is to promote the story of the British Home Children, and to advocate for those who no longer have a voice to provide free research help to those seeking their family histories often providing closure to a painful

past; and

WHEREAS September 28<sup>th</sup> is commemorated nationally as British Home Children Day in

Canada by a unanimous Private members motion M-133 in the House of

Commons, 7 Feb 2018;

NOW, THEREFORE I, Mayor Michelle Staples of the City of Duncan, do hereby proclaim September

28, 2024, as "British Home Children Day" in the City of Duncan.
