AMALGAMATION ASSENT VOTING
ADVANCE NON-RESIDENT PROPERTY ELECTOR REGISTRATION

Advance **non-resident elector** registrations will be accepted at The Corporation of the City of Duncan office, 200 Craig Street, Duncan, BC during regular office hours, until **4:00 pm, Tuesday, May 1, 2018**. Except for registrations on voting days, **non-resident elector** registrations will not be accepted after 4:00 pm on May 1, 2018 to June 23, 2018 (closed period for advance non-resident elector registration).

NON-RESIDENT ELECTOR QUALIFICATIONS

NON-RESIDENT PROPERTY ELECTORS:

- 18 years of age or older on general voting day for the assent voting; and
- a Canadian citizen; and
- a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration; and
- a registered owner of real property within The Corporation of the City of Duncan boundaries for at least 30 days immediately before the day of registration; and
- the only persons who are registered owners of the property, either as joint tenants or tenants in common, are individuals who are not holding the property in trust for a corporation or another trust; and
- not entitled to register as a resident elector; and
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or assent voting and not otherwise disqualified by law; and
- **if there is more than one registered owner of the property, only one of those individuals may, with the written consent of the majority of the owners, register as a non-resident property elector.**
