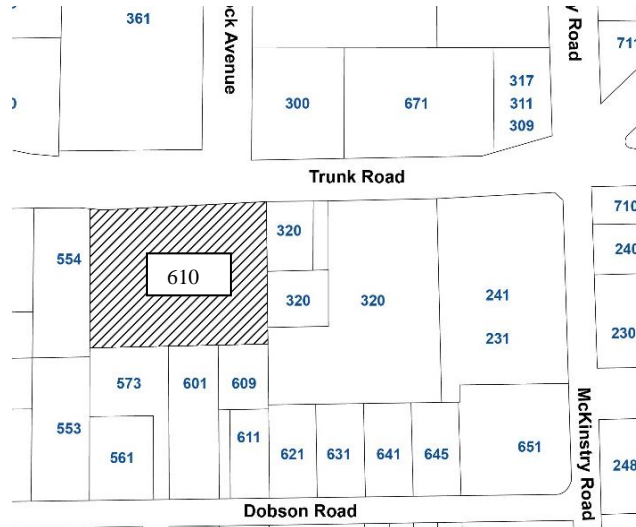




## NOTICE OF NEW TEMPORARY USE PERMIT – 610 TRUNK ROAD

Council will consider issuing a new Temporary Use Permit (TUP) for LOT A, SECTION 16, RANGE 7, QUAMICHAN DISTRICT, PLAN VIP58624, located at 610 Trunk Road, Duncan, BC.



### What is the purpose of the Temporary Use Permit?

The City has received an application to issue a new TUP to authorize the continued use of the subject property for temporary accommodation of up to 40 unsheltered persons in up to 40 modular sleeping units. The previous two TUPs authorized the temporary uses to take place from January 15, 2022 to November 30, 2024. The proposed new TUP, if issued, would be valid for a 25-month term from December 1, 2024 to December 31, 2026.
