AND WHEREAS: Every year more than 1700 children are diagnosed with Cancer in Canada;

AND WHEREAS: Every year in Canada over 300 children under the age of 20 years will lose

their lives to cancer;

AND WHEREAS: Of the children who survive their initial cancer most will develop lifetime

side effects and are much more likely to develop another form of malignant

cancer;

AND WHEREAS: The mental health of children and youth with cancer including their families

should be paramount, and support attainable;

AND WHEREAS: Our children are our most precious resource and are truly valued by all

peoples of British Columbia.
