FILMING NOTICE

Dear Neighbours of Duncan City Hall 200 Craig Street and Impeccable Jewellery 211 Craig Street,

Zeta Productions Inc. will be filming scenes for the TV series titled "Super Pupz" on Tuesday, September 29th, 2020. We would like to provide the following information regarding our schedule and how it may affect your routine:

Monday, September 28th, 2020

7:00AM to 7:00PM

- A prep crew will work on site at Duncan City Hall Square and also at the Craig and Kenneth Intersection preparing our locations for filming.
- Work Trucks will arrive in the evening and park in the vacant lot at 139 Kenneth Street.

Tuesday, September 29th, 2020 (Times Approximate)

7:00AM to 8:00AM

Film crew will arrive on site and prepare the locations for filming.

8:00AM to 10:00AM

Filming will take place at Duncan City Hall Square.

10:00AM to 12:00PM

Filming will take place on the 100 block of Kenneth Street.

12:00PM to 7:00PM

• Filming will take place in front of 211 Craig Street and at the intersection of Craig Street and Kenneth Street. 7:00PM to 8:00PM

Filming will take place in the alley behind 171 and 165 Craig Street.

9:00PM to 10:00PM

• Filming will be completed at this location. Crew will pack trucks and quietly leave the neighbourhood.

Wednesday, September 30th, 2020

- 9:00AM to 11:00AM
 - A wrap crew will work on site at Duncan City Hall Square and also at the Craig Street and Kenneth Street Intersection returning the locations back to their original condition.

The majority of our service vehicles will be parked in an off-site lot however, to accommodate our essential work trucks and the filming of our scenes, we have asked the city of Duncan for the following parking areas and full street traffic closure:

Monday, September 28th, 2020 6:00PM to Tuesday, September 29th, 2020 10:00PM

Gravel lot at 139 Kenneth Street.

- Tuesday, September 29th, 2020 7:00AM to 10:00PM
 - East and West Side of Craig Street from Ingram Street to Station Street.
 - North and South Side of Kenneth Street from Jubilee Street to Canada Ave.

Tuesday, September 29th, 2020 7:00AM to 10:00PM

- Full street traffic closure on Kenneth Street from Jubilee Street to Canada Ave.
 - Full street traffic closure on Craig Street from Ingram Street to Station Street.
- Note: Local traffic will be allowed through sections of our road closure to park in privately owned parking.

We will be using artificial smoke and lighting effects on set to simulate a fire. There is no gunfire or loud noises associated with this filming.
