



## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### RETAIL SALES OF CANNABIS AND CANNABIS RELATED PRODUCTS RFP

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#### RECENT QUESTIONS ASKED:

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1. Is there a map that shows these minimum distances from cannabis stores, schools, daycares, and parks?  
Nanaimo has a "buffer zone" map. This map allows users to easily see which areas in the City are available for use as retail cannabis space. (Submitted January 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2019)

*The City of Duncan does not have formal map showing the preferred buffer zones outlined in the RFP. The buffer zones prescribed are meant to provide direction for the City's preferred locations based on recommendations supported by Council. As the City is very small, using the Zoning Bylaw as a guide may assist the applicant in assessing the preferred locations.*

2. Are there any First Nations lands within Duncan that are not available for retail cannabis zoning use? (Submitted January 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2019)

*Cowichan Tribes will have their own process for managing the retail sale of cannabis. Please contact Cowichan Tribes if you have questions about First Nations lands.*
