

## NOTICE OF TEMPORARY USE PERMIT RENEWAL TUP-2021-01 – 610 TRUNK ROAD

Date: August 3, 2022

This notice is to advise that Council will consider renewing an existing Temporary Use Permit for LOT A, SECTION 16, RANGE 7, QUAMICHAN DISTRICT, PLAN VIP58624, located at 610 Trunk Road, Duncan, BC.



The City has received an application to renew Temporary Use Permit No. TUP-2021-01, which authorized the use of the subject property for temporary accommodation of up to 40 unsheltered persons in up to 40 modular cabins. The original TUP was valid for a period of 8 months from January 15, 2022, to September 30, 2022. The renewed TUP, if approved, would be valid for a further 8 months from September 30, 2022, to May 30, 2023.

The proposed permit will be available for public review from **Thursday, August 4, 2022**, to **Monday, August 15, 2022**, on the City's website, <u>www.duncan.ca</u>.
