• provide conditions sufficient to ensure that each hen maintains good health, including by providing each hen with food, water, shelter, light, ventilation, veterinary care, and opportunity to perform essential behaviors, such as scratching, dust-bathing and roosting;	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>
