

## **Toilet Rebates**



We all love water, drinking it, swimming in it, but down the toilet, not so much!

Do you want to make an impact on your environment and water bill? Switch to high efficiency or dual flush toilets and save water and dollars.

The City is offering a rebate to replace toilets that use 13 litres or more, with a CSA-approved high efficiency model. The rebate is \$50 for a high efficiency (4.8 litres) or dual flush model (3/6 litres). There is a lifetime maximum of two rebates per residential or commercial unit.

Based on data collected by the City of Duncan in 2018, the average customer uses 260 m<sup>3</sup> per year or 712 litres of water each and every day. That's a whopping 260,000 litres per year—on average, per household!

Many homes are equipped with older toilets that require 13 litres or more per flush. New high efficiency toilets require only 4.8 litres per flush and dual flush toilets use a combination of 3 and 6 litres.

By replacing your old toilet, you could use up to 76% *less* water per flush!

The City wants to reduce both water consumption and flows into the sewage system. It costs money to treat the water coming both in and out of your house. Using less water saves money and is better for the environment.

A toilet replacement does not require a permit. However, if you are also renovating, you may require a building permit. Please contact the City's Building Inspector for more information.

### Who is eligible for the rebate?

Property owners that are connected to both the City of Duncan water and sewer systems are eligible for the rebate.

The rebate is also available to those property owners that are supplied the City of Duncan water, are on the City's sewer system or on a self-contained septic system but may not live in the City's boundaries.

### What about my old toilet?

For a small fee, old toilets may be disposed of at Bings Creek Transfer Station, 3900 Drinkwater Road. The City will be working towards a local solution for recycling (crushed and reused) the old toilets, at which point there will be changes to the disposal requirements.



### What do I need to apply?

- Fill out the application form;
- Provide a receipt dated after January 1, 2010 for the purchase of a CSA-approved low flush toilet: and
- Provide the following three photographs:
  - a photograph of the old toilet in place
  - a photograph of the old toilet removed with the tank broken
  - a photograph of the new toilet in place.

You must agree to permit a representative of the City of Duncan access to inspect the installation if determined necessary.

City staff will review your application. If you qualify, you will be mailed a cheque for \$50 per eligible dual flush and/or high efficiency toilet (up to two toilets per residence).

Submission of an application does not guarantee a rebate. The rebate program may be withdrawn at a future date without notice.
