### LIST OF VOTERS

The City uses the Provincial list of voters. If your name is on the Provincial list of voters as of August 15, 2022, you do not need to bring identification to vote.

### VOTING DAY REGISTRATION

To register at the time of voting, please bring two pieces of identification that provide evidence of your identity and place of residence (i.e., Driver's Licence, BC Identification card, Social Insurance Number card, credit card, phone bill, hydro bill, or property tax notice). One piece of identification must contain your signature.

### ELECTOR QUALIFICATIONS

You are eligible to vote at the special voting opportunity as a resident elector if you meet the following requirements:

- a **resident** or **employee** of one of the facilities above;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day for the election;
- a Canadian citizen;
- a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration;
- a resident of the City of Duncan; and
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or assent voting and not otherwise disqualified by law.

**Advance Voting** will be held October 5<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m. at Duncan Fire Hall, 468 Duncan Street, Duncan.

**General Voting** will be held October 15<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m. at Duncan Fire Hall, 468 Duncan Street, Duncan.
